****CAMP RULES****

Cadets Safety

First and foremost, the STAFF takes its responsibility to provide for the safety and welfare of all Cadets. The Camp Rules listed below are the direct result of over 11 years of experience in successful camp administration. Though we rarely have problems, cadets who repeatedly fail to follow the rules will be sent home immediately. Please take a moment to review the Camp Rules with your ward prior to camp.

Cadets Responsibilities

- No Cell phone is allowed during camp, cadets will be allowed to call parents as per the schedule, parents make sure to be available during the time slot provided.
- Cadets are to attend all instructional sessions, team practices and team games on time.
- Cadets must listen to all staff, and be courteous and respectful at all times.
- Always move with your team and Instructors when moving from one activity to the next.
- NO ONE may leave the campus unless they have permission from the camp or Company Instructor. Cadets should not go to the dorm any time without an Instructor
- Once you are at the dorm for the night, you are not allowed to go out.!
- NO illegal substances or alcoholic beverages shall be possessed nor consumed.

Failure to abide by the camp regulations will result in dismissal from the camp and the expense will be borne by the parent.

Cadets Dorm Responsibilities

- Once registration is completed, parents/visitors are not allowed inside of the assigned dorm building. All visits must take place in the dorm entry or right outside of the dorm building.
- Respect of your own space as well as shared space with both your roommate(s) as is essential to the success of camp. Keeping your own space neat and clean is part of the camp experience.
- Security Guard on duty all night who patrols the exterior of our dorm.
- Unknown persons NO visitation allowed in the dorm.
- The Dorm In charge and Care taker will see that all rules and regulations are followed by the cadet inside the dorm.
- Wake-up will be at 5:30 AM by assigned floor counsellors followed by the routine activity & Company wise Roll Call
- Do not change rooms without approval from Dorm In charge.
- Room furniture is not to be moved or damage. Any such incidences will involve disciplinary action.
- The entire camp is under CCTV surveillance at all times.

Dining Hall Expectations

- Absolutely no horseplay, in the DINING area.
- We want you to enjoy your meal, but don't take more than you can eat. **NO WASTAGE of FOOD**
- Trays must be taken to designated area after each meal and should not be left on the dining table.
- Wait patiently in the line. Cadets who take cuts will be moved to the end of the lines.
- Be courteous to the dining hall staff.
- Keep noise down in the dining hall.

lost & Found

- Our objective is to always maintain a safe and fun atmosphere at camp.
- Please make sure that your child's name with surname is on all of his/her belongings. We are not responsible for items lost or damaged at camp.
- Any additional supplies will be charged extra. Especially caps
- To avoid losing a valuable item, we respectfully request that you encourage your ward to leave these items at home.
- This would particularly include hand-held computer games, stuffed animals, iPods-type devices, cell phones and special card/toy collections.
- No Cash should be carried, there will be checking of baggage before entry to the dorm, and if found will be taken and returned on the last day of the camp.
- We have a Lost and Found area in the Camp Office on location.
- Our staff will make every effort to help cadets keep track of their belongings.

Refund Policy

- Fee once paid is Non- Refundable and Non-Transferable.
- If any cancellation occurs due to unavoidable circumstances 30% Fees will be deducted and balance will be returned only after 45 days of the closing of the camp event.
- For early booking, if there is any change in plans, Parents have to Inform us 30 days prior to the opening date of camp and the refund will be initiated from MCF.

Guidelines For Parents

- Age limit for 7 days & 14 days camps are strictly between 7 to 18 yrs., for 21 days & 30 Days camps are strictly between 12 to 18 years
- It's a Commando Training Course and not a Luxurious relaxing Vacation. Discipline is must.
- For boy's military hair cut is a must & for girls they should tie the hair properly by using hair net.
- Medical fitness certificate is a must for every child. Print should be carried at the camp center
- No food items & valuable things are allowed . Cash, any valuables like Mobile Phones, Jewellery, Gadgets, etc. If lost, misplaced or damaged, management will not be responsible for same.
- Calling schedule mentioned in the brochure . Other days Cadets will not be entertained to your call.
- Parents have to reveal to us if the child has undergone any major surgery or having any physical ailment so that we can give the training as per his current situation. Don't discourage them but, surely they can be given substituted exercise.
- The parents will not be allowed to meet the child during training period. You will be invited on the last day to see the demo presented by the children, as per the schedule mentioned in the brochure.
- Your child's safety & security is our concern. First aid facilities are available at the camp site. For any emergency 24hrs. bus service will be available from camp to different places. In unavoidable circumstances if the child has to be admitted in the hospital for certain reasons the cost will be borne by parent.
- During night stay, security guard / female attendant, female instructor & female manager will be constantly staying with the girls. Similarly for Boys .
